The main entrance is reached by old stone steps that tell the stories of past generations, and above them is a 19 square meter terrace, ideal for morning coffee or evening enjoyment with a view of the garden and the distant sea. The residential part of the house is connected to a former farm building, which can be renovated, and together with the house it forms a space that can be transformed into a small guesthouse, restaurant or space for special events - a place where tradition meets modern ideas.
